Hey, friend! Please read this first.

Dear YOU,

I wrote this devotional book for YOU! But it turns out, I also wrote this devotional book for me.

For almost 7 years I wrote and worked on this labor of love. 365 different devotional thoughts with scripture, prayer and application, plus 1 for leap year is a lot y'all! But with a ton of prayer, intentionality and hard work over the years, I believe it is going to be a blessing. At least I hope so!

Years ago I was the lead pastor of a new church plant in York, PA. It ended up being one of the most amazing experiences of my life which ended up also leading to one of the most painful seasons of my life. That's another book entirely, but context is important.

Starting a new church is hard! Like, don't do it unless Jesus makes it abundantly clear that you can't do anything else, kind of hard. But you also get to see God do amazing things in the process! One of those things was connecting

with people that were completely new to church, faith, Jesus, all of it!

I grew up in church, but in most cases it seemed like we did church really well for church people. But I wanted people to know about the hope that Jesus brought into my life, especially people that had never experienced God in that kind of way. Of course I wanted to help followers of Jesus grow in their faith, but also focus attention on people that were on a new faith journey and help them grow in their faith and relationship with Jesus.

In order for most plants, fruit, and vegetables to grow, they need certain elements. Important things like, seeds, soil, water and sunshine. I know there are others and some don't need all of these things, but most do. Faith and a relationship with Jesus also need some important elements in order to grow.

Along with relationships and community, worship, prayer and time in the Bible are important elements in our faith journey.

But I found out that many of our friends that were new to faith, struggled with reading the bible and praying on a regular basis. It turns out,

that's pretty true for people that have claimed to follow Jesus for a long time as well.

Many devotionals (books focused on spiritual growth), that I came across at that time were overly complicated and hard to process, or just not enough. Like many other popular books that are published, many devotionals are not even written by the big names on the cover.

I struggled with reading and comprehension myself growing up, so I decided to try and write a devotional that I probably would have read when I got serious about my faith as a teenager. Recently I heard author and speaker Rory Vaden on a podcast interview with Jon Acuff say, "You are most powerfully positioned to serve the person you once were." So here we are!

Earlier I wrote that this devotional book is for you, but I ended up writing it for me too. If you spend intentional time writing, praying, researching and thinking about scripture for a long time, you also grow in your faith and relationship with Jesus.

So I do hope this book blesses you, and of course I want it to put a smile on the face of Jesus. But it's also a snapshot from 7 years of my

life, while I was trying to hold on to Jesus and help others know him more even while I was also walking through an incredible amount of pain and change in my life.

Psalm 46:1 reminds us that God is an ever-present help in times of trouble. And He is! He still is!! And that's the God I want you to know and fall in love with. And one way to do that is with time in scripture, prayer, and with applying those things.

In John 15:5 Jesus reminds us how important it is to stay connected to Him when He says, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."

So if we will respond to His invitation to connect with Him and stay connected to Him, we will bear much fruit. In other words, our life will be better if we remain connected to God. This was once going to be called the Remain Devo for that very reason.

I wrote this devotional to create space for us to intentionally connect with Jesus through scripture, a brief thought, prayer and application. What you have in your hands is 365

hope-filled devotions to help you consistently draw closer to Jesus and grow in your faith daily. I pray it is an encouragement to you.

This devotional book is laid out intentionally. It starts with 1 verse. If you don't typically read the bible but read that 1 verse a day, you've got 365 verses in for the year. Better than none!

At the bottom of each page there are 4 scripture references in a one year read through the bible format. The verse of the day came out of that reading. But if you want to go further, read those references and you will read through the entire bible in a year. The entire daily devo will take about 15 minutes a day to read if you read those references and if you read as slow as me.

Then there is the devotional thought that I wrote to correspond with the verse of the day, and a brief prayer and 2 application questions. It would not be a bad idea to keep a journal to respond to the 2 questions. But that's all up to you!

The hashtags #DontDoLifeAloneDevo and #ReadPrayApplyRemain are also included on every page. They are a reminder of what you are doing, but also there to remind you to share this

with others. If a particular day sticks out to you, post it on social media with those hashtags. And years from now if hashtags fall off the cliff and mean nothing again, don't discount them! They may make a comeback like mullets and fanny packs are right now! If you don't know what I'm talking about, let's move on.

This, Don't Do Life Alone Devo, is for YOU!

Now, read, pray, apply and remain!

This is what you are about to do. And I promise, if you spend time reading the Bible and processing it with the devotional thought, praying about it and then figuring out how to apply it in your life, you will grow in your faith and your relationship with Jesus. Because this is not my idea, it's His!

God never intended for us to do life alone. So do this with a friend, or your spouse, child or even your entire family. Get some people together and form a small group. Meet up weekly to discuss what you took away from the weeks readings, or connect with friends online where you can exchange messages to encourage each other.

If this is helpful at all, please go on Amazon and write a review and tell people about it. I'm not just telling you this because I want to sell more books. I mean I do! But the impact is more important than the dollars. This book is 7 years worth of writing, praying and processing that developed over my 39 years so far on this planet and my own personal faith journey. There is a lot invested in this. And my prayer is, that you receive the blessings from all of that.

So I wrote this devotional book for me, but I also wrote it for YOU. For us!

Let's take some intentional next steps together. Let's work through the pages of this book, processing God's word, spending some time in prayer and working to apply it as God leads us.

It does not matter what day you start reading it, just start! God is ready to meet you where you are, when you're ready. You are loved! Your best days are ahead, friend. God is not finished with your story.

Don't do life alone.
